Working to have Home Numbers be Compliant

A BIG Thank You to the Sangaree neighbors that have worked to get your house numbers into code. This is an important step to make the job of locating homes easier. First Responders, Contracted Workers, Sangaree Crew, and your guests benefit from being able to see you home numbers clearly. Per the ordinance (Code §56.69), Houses are to display addresses with 4" contrasting numerals and have 3" numbers on their mailboxes. Numbers blocked by decoration or plant growth are considered Non-compliant.

Code Enforcement officials continue to work in the community to make sure all homes come into compliance of this ordinance.

SANGAREE SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT CONTRACTOR SERVICES

The Sangaree Special Tax District is fully aware of the contractor issues and concerns regarding household waste, yard debris, and bulk pick-up in the district. The administration is working with Berkeley County and Republic Services to fix the problems.

Regarding Contracted services, if you have items placed at curbside before 7:00 am and not picked up by 7:00pm, please call the SSTD Office 843-871-9720 no later than 10:30 am the next business day to report the missed service. Contractors have 24 hours to make up the service once notified.

SANGAREE SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT CREW SERVICES

Items for Limb chipping and removal must be placed <u>curbside no later than Monday</u> <u>mornings at 7:00am</u>. Items placed at curbside after that time will be chipped the following week. Chipping may take a few days, based on amounts left at curbside by residents.

Please see pages 4 & 5 for more information and specific details. If you have any questions or concerns, please call the office **BEFORE** your tree work begins.

AS A REMINDER: Construction and demolition debris should not be placed at curbside as these items will not be removed. Please call the office with any questions **BEFORE** your project begins. More details can be found on pages 4 and 5.



New Hours for Berkeley County Convenience Centers

Berkeley County Council approved new hours and days of operation for the Berkeley County convenience center locations. Starting October 1, 2019, Berkeley County convenience centers will be CLOSED Wednesdays and Sundays of every week. The sites will be open from

7a.m.- 6p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Hours for the Berkeley County landfill will remain the same. Additionally, the County will soon be adding another convenience center off Redbank Road. This site is expected to open the first quarter of 2020. TALKING TRASH

Carts must be placed curbside before 7:00 am on your collection day. Your garbage may be collected anytime between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. The Sangaree contractor, Republic Services is contracted to pick up **ONLY** the cart and empty the contents.

Carts must be placed curbside, wheels facing your home, opening facing the street, 3 feet clear from all obstructions (such as parked cars, mailboxes, fire hydrants, utility boxes, additional carts, etc.). Report ANY problems with carts to Sangaree Special Tax District at 843-871-9720.

Report Missed service **no-later-than 10:00 am** the next business day.

The roll carts (trash can on wheels) are the property of the service contractor and must remain at the house when residents move. Please do not remove carts from vacant residences.

PROPER DISPOSAL OF PAINT CANS

Berkeley County does **not** have a paint recycling program. For disposal, paint must be hardened using a substance such as kitty litter or mortar mix before disposing into the regular trash. All paint must be completely dry. Once completely dry, it may be placed in the household waste roll cart. **The landfill cannot accept any liquids.**

HOME ELECTRONICS (E-WASTE) WILL BE PICKED UP ON MONDAYS

Monday mornings is the day to dispose of your *e*-waste. Items such as TVs, computers, other home entertainment components, monitors, printers and scanners, etc. are included in this type of pick up. Items must be placed curbside by 7:00am on Mondays. In the event of a Monday holiday, this service will take place on Tuesday.



LARGE APPLIANCES & BULK ITEMS

Items should be placed curbside by 7:00am **MONDAY** mornings. Washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators,

grills, bicycles, lawnmowers and any other metal items can be picked up.

Refrigerator and/or freezer doors MUST be removed.

ITEMS MUST BE

EMPTY.

REMOVAL OF CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS IS NOT A PROVIDED SERVICE. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HOMEOWNER OR CONTRACTOR. PLEASE CONTACT THE OFFICE FOR MORE DETAILS IF NECESSARY. 843-871-9720

TREE REMOVAL

SANGAREE WILL REMOVE ALL LIMBS, BRANCHES, AND TRUNKS UP TO FOUR INCHES IN DIAMETER. ANYTHING LARGER THAN FOUR INCHES IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR OR HOMEOWNER TO REMOVE.

DISPOSING OF YARD & TREE DEBRIS

<u>YARD WASTE:</u> YARD WASTE INCLUDES PLANT MATERIAL REMOVED FROM THE YARD ONLY Bricks, concrete edging or stones/rocks are **NOT CONSIDERED YARD WASTE**. Lawn furniture, fixtures, or decorations should be placed at curbside and collected with other BULK on Wednesday;

LOOSE YARD WASTE: Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, pine cones, and trimmings from plants. Bagged in biodegradable **PAPER** bags (<u>NOT PLASTIC</u>) or placed in a container, such as a trash can, clearly marked "yard waste". Regulations prohibit the use of the same container for household trash and yard waste. Contained loose yard waste cannot exceed **65 pounds each**. Containers without lids must allow for drainage of rain water. **Bagged OR Contained dirt will NOT be collected**.

<u>LIMBS:</u> This service begins on Mondays Trunks and branches not exceeding four inches in diameter will be collected. Limbs are collected and chipped into a truck. Cut out forks, stack in an orderly pile not exceeding 4' high, with the cut ends towards the street. This allows for curbside collection as employees are not allowed to enter private property. Large quantities of limbs may be stacked in multiple, smaller piles or a continuous row.

<u>Logs:</u> Trunks and branches larger than four inches in diameter are the responsibility of the homeowner/landlord to remove.

Make Way on Trash Collection Day! Please do not street park in cul-desacs, block trash carts, or prevent the Sangaree contractors from accessing the work you need them to complete. They are working with

What are the responsibilities of the SSTD in Sangaree?

Residents of Sangaree Special Tax District receive public services and/or improvements, which could not otherwise conveniently or equitably be provided by Berkeley County. Some of the services we receive in Sangaree include, but are not limited to:



- 1) **Waste Management Service** Residents have solid waste collected weekly that include household waste, furniture, appliances, yard waste, and tree limbs.
- 2) **Recreation** Residents enjoy Community Events along with a Community Park, Spring Lake Park; Four playgrounds: Cambridge, Raintree, Pierre, & Lyons Cove; 44 green spaces; Fitness Park; ALL maintained by Sangaree.
- 3) **Fire Protection** C & B Fire Department Sangaree Station and Pine Ridge Fire Department
- 4) **Maintenance** Landscaper, General Maintenance crew, and an Administrative Staff work for Sangaree. Additional services are provided by the use of contracts with private companies approved by Berkeley County Council.

Some of you may wonder what are the areas maintained by the SSTD Crew? There are parks, playgrounds, and green spaces within Sangaree. The Sangaree crew is responsible for those properties.

The Sangaree crew is not responsible for private property or the easement afforded property owners for access by utility or service workers. Please stop by the SSTD Administrative Office if you would like to read the complete document of State of South Carolina, County of Berkeley Restrictive Covenants.


