## THERE'S A NEW KID IN TOWN

Sangaree begins a new year with some exciting changes! Getting 2724 + new trash carts delivered was no small task, but having new clean carts all around Sangaree is a great sight. Capital Waste Services continues to keep a presence in Sangaree to meet the needs and requests of neighbors during the transition. Information about second carts is available by calling 843-875-2556. As a reminder, please use bags to contain your household trash before placing it in your cart. Loose items can fall out while dumping and blow around the neighborhood. Not only will this help keep your community looking better, it will help the carts stay cleaner, longer. Also, do not place prohibited items in the household waste cart. Your cart will not be serviced if inappropriate items are placed inside. The Berkeley County Convenience Center, located at 606 Oakley Road, is for county residents to use. **Containers from prior contractors are the property of that contractor & must be surrendered. Please be sure to place these empty carts at the curbside for collection. Old contractor carts may not be used for yard debris and will also be collected.**

The next Public Meeting of the Sangaree Special Tax District Advisory Commission will be open to all Sangaree residents via ZOOM. If you do not already have ZOOM, you can join from your browser. Enter the meeting code **920 9729 3759** and you are in! You can get the latest updates such as the status of 2021-2022 projected plans for Sangaree, lots of helpful information, and more. You also have the ability to interact and make a brief comment, too. Standard Public Meeting rules are still in place allowing four minutes each for residents to have an opportunity to speak if they so desire. **ZOOM** with Sangaree on August 3!

## **AN OVERVIEW OF CHIPPING SERVICES IN SANGAREE**

Chipping of branches from a trimmed tree has been a provided service in Sangaree for many years. This service still continues today and Sangaree would like to reiterate the requirements to continue to provide this service with safety & efficiency. If you have a contractor do the work, the home owner or the contractor is responsible for removing any pieces over four inches in diameter.

Chipping is the service being provided. Trunks and large blocks will NOT be removed by Sangaree. Limbs must be a manageable length not to exceed four inches wide. Limbs must be placed in stacks, not tangled piles, by the curbside. There must not be any other debris placed with the limbs. No blocks, trunks, household bulk, or trash, etc. If the debris is a pile of everything, it will not be removed.

Branches to be chipped MUST be placed at curbside no-later-than 7:00AM on Mondays. The crew worksheet is created at 7:00am on Monday mornings. This is used by the crew to plan their work week. Items placed at curbside after 7:00am will be added to the worksheet for removal the following week beginning on Monday. ## **BULK ITEM REMOVAL REMINDERS**

Bulk item removal is a Curbside Service in Sangaree. Items considered 'Bulk' could be a sofa, chair, lamp, rolled area rug, child's large toy, etc. Bulk pick up does not include, moveout trash piles, garage cleanups, evictions, construction/renovation projects, and other excessive piles. This type of removal is the responsibility of the Homeowner/Landlord.

## **MISSED SERVICES IN SANGAREE**

There are a variety of curbside services in Sangaree. Trash pick-up, Yard Debris pickup, Chipping, and Bulk Item Pickup. If you feel your service has been missed after properly placing items out for pickup, please call the Sangaree Office **NO LATER THAN 10:30AM** the next business day so make-up service can be scheduled. 843-871-9720. Thank you.

**AS A REMINDER: DO NOT BLOCK ACCESS TO CURBSIDE ITEMS ON SERVICE DAYS. YOU OR YOUR NEIGHBORS WILL NOT BE SERVICED. THANK YOU.**

## STREET SIGN REPLACEMENT

In 2018, Sangaree Special Tax District Crew began a replacement program for all the street signs in Sangaree. You may have noticed some sub-divisions have been completed with the most recent being Indian Woods.

The signs are made of aluminum with high intensity, reflective lettering that will last for many years to come. The new treated posts are being cut and stained by the crew while the next set of panels are in production.

Along the way, there has been replacement of other signs throughout Sangaree due to severe aging or accidental damage. That practice will continue as needed.

The next area scheduled for replacement is the Village Green subdivision. Other subdivisions will follow over the next two years.

## SERVICE SCHEDULE REMINDERS

### HOUSEHOLD TRASH IN CARTS

Carts must be placed curbside before 6:30 am on your collection day. Your waste may be collected anytime between **6:30am and 7:00pm**. The Sangaree contractor, Capital Waste, is contracted to pick up **ONLY** the cart and empty the contents - NO additional bags/containers.

### HOME ELECTRONICS (E-WASTE)

Monday mornings is the day to dispose of your e-waste. TVs, computers (destroy your hard drive, first), and other like components. **Collection begins at 7:00am.**

### LARGE APPLIANCES/METAL

Monday mornings washers, dryer, water heaters, refrigerators, grills, bicycles, lawn mowers, and any other metal items can be picked up. **Collection begins at 7:00am.**

### CHIPPING

Monday & Tuesday chipping limbs & branches, not to exceed 4 inches in diameter. **Collection begins at 7:00am.**

### BULK/FURNITURE ITEMS

Wednesday is the day for Bulk pick-up. Items like a couch, mattress, lamp, cardboard, etc., must be placed at curbside. **Collection begins at 6:30am.**

### BAGGED/CONTAINED YARD DEBRIS

Wednesday is Yard Waste (grass clippings, leaves, pine straw, fine prunings) contained in paper bags (NOT PLASTIC) or cans labeled YARD WASTE. **Collection begins at 6:30am.**

### LARGE RENOVATION PROJECTS

Please consider renting a roll-off container to dispose of your renovation/construction debris. Sangaree crews and contractors are not permitted to remove this type of debris.

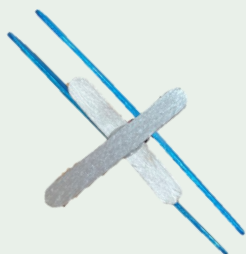

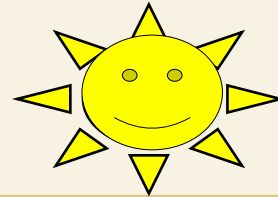
