UPDATE: SANGAREE FITNESS AREA

The layout for the Fitness area adjacent to Pierre Park has begun. 811 crews came and marked the area for utility locations. Sangaree Crew immediately measured, marked and began digging and placing equipment at Pierre Park. There are a variety of stopping points along the work out trail. You will be able to start with a good stretch and loosen up, followed by testing your balance, pull ups, sit ups, vertical ladder, horizontal ladder, and more. Each station will have a description of appropriate activities for the area marked to guide you. More pieces will be added in the coming weeks as the course nears completion. 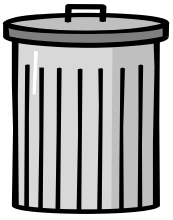

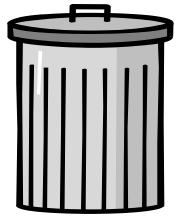

TALKING TRASH



TRASH COLLECTION BEGINS AT 7:00 AM EACH COLLECTION DAY.
 ANYTHING PLACED AT THE CURB AFTER 7:00 AM
 MAY NOT BE COLLECTED.

GUIDELINES FOR SETTING OUT GARBAGE

The roll carts (trash can on wheels) are the property of the service contractor and must remain at the house when residents move.

Carts must be placed curbside before 7:00 am on your collection day. Your garbage may be collected anytime between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. **Carts must be placed curbside, wheels facing your home, 3 feet from all obstructions** (such as parked cars, mailboxes, fire hydrants, utility boxes, additional carts, etc.). Report **ANY** problems with carts to Sangaree Special Tax District at 843-871-9720. Report Missed service **no-later-than 11:00am** the next business day.

LARGE APPLIANCES & BULK ITEMS

Washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, grills, bicycles, lawnmowers and any other metal item larger than 9" x 48". **ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY.**

HOME ELECTRONICS (E-WASTE)

TVs/other home entertainment components, as well as computers, monitors, printers and scanners, etc.

PROPER DISPOSAL OF PAINT CANS

All paint must be completely dry. This can be achieved by opening the can and letting it sit until the paint is hard or by adding sand or cat litter to the can to absorb the paint. Once completely dry, it may be placed in the household waste roll cart.

RECYCLING - EVERY OTHER FRIDAY

Place recycling in bins obtained from the Sangaree Special Tax District office. **Do not use plastic bags to contain your recycling.** Items that are not acceptable will be left in your container after collection.

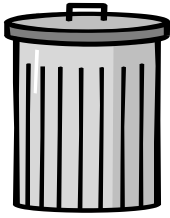
Place your recycling container at the curb.

COMMINGLES - (plastic, glass, metal)

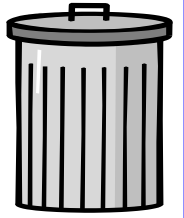
- **Plastic: #1 - #7 plastic containers.**
- Rinse and remove caps with the exception of cooking oil & motor oil bottles which should be un-rinsed with lids on. Labels are okay.
- **Glass: Unbroken jars and bottles.**
- Rinse and remove lids. Labels are okay. No mirrors, panes of glass or light bulbs.
- **Metal: Aluminum and steel cans.** Also, aluminum foil, pie pans, and empty aerosol cans. Rinse, labels are okay.

PAPER - Newspapers, magazines, mixed office paper, junk mail, store sales flyers, phone books, etc. placed in brown paper bags or recycle bin.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD - Remove packing material (Styrofoam, bubble wrap), collapse boxes and place inside recycle cart. For excessive amounts, contact the SSTD Office.



TALKING TRASH



HOUSEHOLD WASTE & RECYCLE ARE SCHEDULED TO BE PICKED UP BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00AM & 7:00PM. TO REPORT MISSED SERVICE PLEASE CALL THE SSTO OFFICE NO LATER THAN 11:00AM THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY.

IF YOU HAVE A CONTRACTOR REMOVE BRANCHES, LIMBS, OR TREES AND DEBRIS FROM YOUR HOME, THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING THE DEBRIS FROM THE PROPERTY. IF YOU HAVE RENOVATION, CONSTRUCTION. AND/OR DEMOLITION WORK DONE BY A CONTRACTOR, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO DISPOSE OF REMOVED ITEMS.

YARD WASTE: Yard waste includes plant material removed from yard, NOT lawn furniture, fixtures, or decorations which are collected with furniture; no bricks, concrete edging or stones/rocks.

Keep the following three types of yard waste separate from each other and from other types of solid waste as they are collected separately.

LOOSE YARD WASTE: Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, pine cones, and trimmings from plants. Bagged in biodegradable **PAPER** bags (**NOT PLASTIC**) or placed in a container, such as a trash can, clearly marked "yard waste". Regulations prohibit the use of the same container for household trash and yard waste. Contained loose yard waste cannot exceed **65 pounds each**. Containers without lids must allow for drainage of rain water. **Bagged dirt will NOT be collected.**

LIMBS: Trunks and branches not exceeding four inches in diameter. Limbs are collected and chipped into a truck. Cut out forks, stack in an orderly pile not exceeding 4' high, with the cut ends towards the street. This allows for curbside collection as employees are not allowed to enter private property. Large quantities of limbs may be stacked in several piles or a continuous row.

Berkeley County holds groundbreaking for new recycling facility

Production set to begin in early 2019

MONCKS CORNER, S.C.- (Wednesday, April 11, 2018) Berkeley County leaders will break ground at the new County recycling facility on Tuesday, April 17 at 10 a.m., located at 646 Oakley Road in Moncks Corner. The South Carolina-based company, RePower South (RPS), has begun construction of the Berkeley County Recycling and Recovery Facility.

RPS presented their sustainable option in 2016, when the County's contract with the previous provider expired. After efforts to renegotiate resulted in substantially higher prices for Berkeley County residents, Berkeley County leaders began exploring a new direction for the County's recycling services. Rather than invest and run the County's own recycle material recovery facility, Berkeley County entered in a public-private partnership with RPS.

Under the terms of agreement, Berkeley County will pay RPS to process the County's waste. After they extract the recyclable material, they will then pay the County to landfill the residual. RPS will also pay the County a lease to operate on its landfill, as well as a revenue share of the sale of the recyclable material and fuel.

Residents will receive recycling services at no additional cost. No sorting is required. When production begins in early 2019, the Moncks Corner plant will process 50 tons-per-hour of mixed waste sourced from Berkeley County to recover recycled goods and a fuel feedstock.

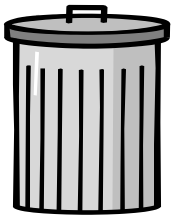
Additionally, this facility will create 60 new jobs in Berkeley County.

"This innovative approach to recycling is bringing Berkeley County, and South Carolina, into the 21st century," said Berkeley County Supervisor Bill Peagler, "This method encourages citizens to do what is environmentally friendly, without the hassle of sorting, proving it is possible to increase recycling efforts in communities."

"This system allows us to cost effectively increase a community's recycling as well as produce a low carbon, clean fuel from waste that is typically landfilled," said RPS President Bob Shepard. "We are very excited to bring this solution to the citizens of Berkeley County, SC and are grateful to the leadership of Berkeley County for selecting RPS and systems partners."

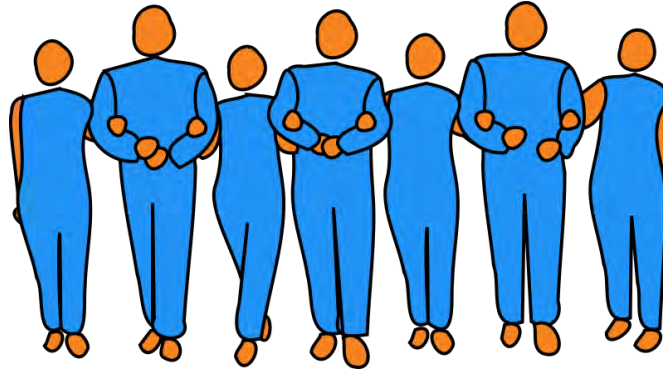
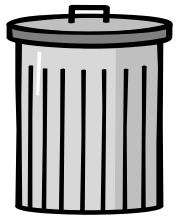

TALKING TRASH

PROVIDED SERVICES



The Sangaree crew has a set list of special services within the boundaries of Sangaree. Fire Protection (providing space and two crew members for C & B Fire Dept.), Solid Waste Collection, Recreation (parks & playground maintenance), and Maintenance of Common Areas. As of September 1, the office and shop will return to focusing on these core tasks. This will come as a change to some residents in the community. It should have been the practice all along per the establishment of the Sangaree Special Tax District and your Sangaree Special Tax District Advisory Commission. NOT INCLUDED IN COLLECTION SERVICE

Hazardous materials such as paint, antifreeze, used motor oil, used oil filters, etc., are not included in the collection service. For further information on disposal locations and proper disposal guidelines, contact the Landfill at 843-572-4400.

Homeowner Contracted Service Companies hired by individual homeowners for home improvements, tree removal, landscaping, or other indoor/outdoor improvements are responsible for the removal of the unwanted debris and materials.

Construction & Demolition materials (C&D) from home building and remodeling projects (including carpet and padding), landscape timbers, pool liners and pallets will not be picked up. It is the responsibility of the home owner to arrange for proper disposal of these types of items.

The resident is responsible for proper disposal of any item not included in the collection service.

Berkeley County Litter Control can enforce clean-up of improperly placed solid waste materials. Residential solid waste collection service is not intended for Sangaree Parkway, Berkeley Drive or any green area. Curbside collection service is limited to residential streets.

What are the responsibilities of the SSTD in Sangaree?

Residents of Sangaree Special Tax District receive public services and/or improvements, which could not otherwise conveniently or equitably be provided by Berkeley County. Some of the services we receive in Sangaree include, but are not limited to:



- 1) **Waste Management Service** - Residents have solid waste collected weekly that include household waste, recyclables, furniture, appliances, yard waste, and tree limbs.
- 2) **Recreation** – Residents enjoy an annual Community Day Event along with 44 parks, playgrounds, and green spaces maintained by Sangaree
- 3) **Fire Protection** – C & B Fire Department Sangaree Station and Pine Ridge Fire Department
- 4) **Maintenance**— Landscaper, General Maintenance crew, and an Administrative Staff work for Sangaree. Additional services are provided by the use of contracts with private companies approved by Berkeley County Council.

Some of you may wonder what are the areas maintained by the SSTD Crew? There are parks, playgrounds, and green spaces within Sangaree. The Sangaree crew is responsible for those properties.

The Sangaree crew is not responsible for private property or the easement afforded property owners for access by utility or service workers. Please stop by the SSTD Administrative Office if you would like to read the complete document of State of South Carolina, County of Berkeley Restrictive Covenants.
