## RECYCLING IS COMING BACK AND ALL OF SANGAREE IS IN!

It's getting closer! The Berkeley County Re-Power South Recycling and Recovery Facility IS coming! The facility will process mixed waste to separate recyclables such as aluminum and plastics from county collections and process non-recyclable materials into a substitute for coal fuel. Approximately 60 jobs are expected to be created. The facility will be located at the current Berkeley County landfill in Moncks Corner and is expected to open later this year. It will handle 50 tons of mixed waste per hour using optical sorters.

RePower South President, Robert Shepard, said that the system will both increase Berkeley County's recycling as well as produce a low carbon, clean fuel from waste below the cost of traditional recycling programs and landfilling. "Our platform enables greater recycling recovery and does so across the entire Berkeley County waste stream. We also create a low-carbon, clean fuel to help reduce the consumption of coal," he said. "Greater recycling, less landfilling, and cleaner air at lower cost is a true win-win for Berkeley County."

#### **Address Numbers**

In May of 2018, Code Enforcement Officer Kale reminded the Sangaree Community of Ordinance (Code §56.69), Houses are to display addresses with 4" contrasting numerals and have 3" numbers on their mailboxes. Thank you to the many Sangaree residents who have already made the appropriate changes. Code Enforcement officials are sweeping the community to make sure all homes are in compliance of this ordinance. Numbers must be the correct size in contrasting color to the home and be clearly visible from the road. Numbers blocked by decoration or plant growth are considered Non-compliant. Thank you!

However, crime, vandalism, and other issues can prevent your community from feeling and being as safe as you'd like it to be. - 4. Speak with the Advisory Commission & County representatives. Tell them you do care.

#### HOME!

- 1. Install a home security system. DON'T post your name outside your home.

- 3. Lock you doors and windows on your home. Set light timers.
- 4. Lock your vehicles
- 5. Tell a trusted neighbor if you plan to be away

#### **TALKING TRASH**

Carts must be placed curbside before 7:00 am on your collection day. Your garbage may be collected anytime between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. The Sangaree contractor, Republic Services is contracted to pick up **ONLY** the cart and empty the contents.

Carts must be placed curbside, wheels facing your home, opening facing the street, 3 feet clear from all obstructions (such as parked cars, mailboxes, fire hydrants, utility boxes, additional carts, etc.). Report ANY problems with carts to Sangaree Special Tax District at 843-871-9720.

Report Missed service **no-later-than 10:00 am** the next business day.

The roll carts (trash can on wheels) are the property of the service contractor and must remain at the house when residents move. Please do not remove carts from vacant residences.

## PROPER DISPOSAL OF PAINT CANS

Berkeley County does **not** have a paint recycling program. For disposal, paint must be hardened using a substance such as kitty litter or mortar mix before disposing into the regular trash. All paint must be completely dry. Once completely dry, it may be placed in the household waste roll cart. **The landfill cannot accept any liquids.** 

## HOME ELECTRONICS (E-WASTE) WILL BE PICKED UP ON MONDAYS

Monday mornings is the day to dispose of your e-waste. Items such as TVs, computers, other home entertainment components, monitors, printers and scanners, etc. are included in this type of pick up. Items must be placed curbside by 7:00am on Mondays. In the event of a Monday holiday, this service will take place on Tuesday.



#### LARGE APPLIANCES & BULK ITEMS

Items should be placed curbside by 7:00am MONDAY mornings. Washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, grills, bicycles, lawnmowers and any other metal items.

Refrigerator and/or freezer doors must be removed.

ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY.

#### **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS**

REMOVAL OF CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS IS NOT A PROVIDED SERVICE. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HOMEOWNER OR CONTRACTOR.

#### TREE REMOVAL

SANGAREE WILL REMOVE ALL LIMBS, BRANCHES, AND TRUNKS UP TO FOUR INCHES IN DIAMETER. ANYTHING LARGER THAN FOUR INCHES IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR OR HOMEOWNER TO REMOVE.

Make Way on Trash Collection Day! Please do not street park in cul-desacs, block trash carts, or prevent the Sangaree contractors from accessing the work you need them to complete. They are working with us to keep our community clean.

#### PLEASE SEPARATE THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF YARD DEBRIS

<u>YARD WASTE:</u> Yard waste includes plant material removed from yard, NOT lawn furniture, fixtures, or decorations which are collected with furniture; no bricks, concrete edging or stones/rocks.

<u>LOOSE YARD WASTE:</u> Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, pine cones, and trimmings from plants. Bagged in biodegradable **PAPER** bags (**NOT PLASTIC**)

or placed in a container, such as a trash can, clearly marked "yard waste".

Regulations prohibit the use of the same container for household trash and yard waste. Contained loose yard waste cannot exceed **65 pounds each**. Containers without lids must allow for drainage of rain water. **Bagged OR Contained dirt will NOT be collected**.

**<u>LIMBS:</u>** Trunks and branches **not exceeding four inches in diameter** will be

collected. Limbs are collected and chipped into a truck. Cut out forks, stack in an orderly pile not exceeding 4' high, with the cut ends towards the street. This allows for curbside collection as employees are not allowed to enter private property. Large quantities of limbs may be stacked in multiple, smaller piles or a continuous row.

<u>Logs:</u> Trunks and branches larger than four inches in diameter are the responsibility of the homeowner/landlord to remove.



## **Service Reminders**

#### **NOT INCLUDED IN COLLECTION SERVICE**

Hazardous materials such as paint, antifreeze, used motor oil, used oil filters, etc., are not included in the collection service. For further information on disposal locations and proper disposal guidelines, contact the Landfill at 843-572-4400.

Homeowner Contracted Service Companies hired by individual homeowners for home improvements, tree removal, landscaping, or other indoor/outdoor improvements are responsible for the removal of the unwanted debris and materials.

**Construction & Demolition materials (C&D)** from home building and remodeling projects (including carpet and padding), landscape timbers, pool liners and pallets will not be picked up. It is the responsibility of the home owner to arrange for proper disposal of these types of items.

The resident is responsible for proper disposal of any item not included in the collection service.

**Berkeley County Litter Control** can enforce clean-up of improperly placed solid waste materials. Residential solid waste collection service is not intended for Sangaree Parkway, Berkeley Drive or any green area. Curbside collection service is limited to residential streets.



#### What are the responsibilities of the SSTD in Sangaree?

Residents of Sangaree Special Tax District receive public services and/or improvements, which could not otherwise conveniently or equitably be provided by Berkeley County. Some of the services we receive in Sangaree include, but are not limited to:

- 1) **Waste Management Service** Residents have solid waste collected weekly that include household waste, recyclables, furniture, appliances, yard waste, and tree limbs.
- 2) Recreation Residents enjoy annual Community Events along with One park: Spring Lake; Four playgrounds: Cambridge, Raintree, Pierre, & Lyons Cove; 44 green spaces; One NEW Fitness Park; ALL maintained by Sangaree
- 3) **Fire Protection** C & B Fire Department Sangaree Station and Pine Ridge Fire Department
- 4) **Maintenance** Landscaper, General Maintenance crew, and an Administrative Staff work for Sangaree. Additional services are provided by the use of contracts with private companies approved by Berkeley County Council.

Some of you may wonder what are the areas maintained by the SSTD Crew? There are parks, playgrounds, and green spaces within Sangaree. The Sangaree crew is responsible for those properties.

The Sangaree crew is not responsible for private property or the easement afforded property owners for access by utility or service workers. Please stop by the SSTD Administrative Office if you would like to read the complete document of State of South Carolina, County of Berkeley Restrictive Covenants.


