AUTUMN IS A GREAT TIME TO TIDY

The weather is starting to be very pleasant and it is a great time for Fall Cleaning. Many of the homes are already showing beautiful autumn décor as residents prepare for the seasons ahead. Sangaree is working cooperatively with Berkeley County Office of Code Enforcement to be pro-active in making Sangaree a great place to live.

As discussed at the Community Meeting, beginning November 13, Code Enforcement will be stepping up patrol in the community in an effort to communicate with home owners and landlords to create a better neighborhood environment. There will be a focus on violations that can jeopardize the safety of neighbors and create health hazards. From overgrown hedges, trees, and grass that can challenge road and entry clearances and access to making homeowners, landlords, and renters accountable for the upkeep of their homes and conditions of their property and belongings.

Residents are encouraged to assist in this effort by taking care of their homes and property or by contacting the Code Enforcement team with questions or concerns (843-719-4758). Berkeley County Code Enforcement provides a valuable service to the community and will help to make Sangaree a great place to live!

TALKING TRASH



TRASH COLLECTION BEGINS AT 7:00 AM EACH COLLECTION DAY.
ANYTHING PLACED AT THE CURB AFTER 7:00 AM
MAY NOT BE COLLECTED.

WINTER HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be **no service** on the following holidays as the landfill is closed: Thanksgiving, Thursday, Nov. 23, 2017; **Christmas Day, Monday, Dec. 25, 2017**; **New Year's Day, Monday, Jan. 1, 2018**. **Recycling will be delayed ONE day for Friday, December 29 and take place on Saturday, December 30**. The collection schedule **MAY** be delayed one day for the remainder of the week after the holiday. **Updates and changes will be announced and posted as needed.**

GUIDELINES FOR SETTING OUT GARBAGE

The roll carts (trash can on wheels) are the property of the service contractor and must remain at the house when residents move.

Carts must be placed curbside before 7:00 am on your collection day. Your garbage may be collected anytime between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. **Carts must be placed curbside, wheels facing your home, 3 feet from all obstructions** (such as parked cars, mailboxes, fire hydrants, utility boxes, additional carts, etc.). Report **ANY** problems with carts to Sangaree Special Tax District at 843-871-9720. Report Missed service **no-later-than 11:00am** the next business day.

LARGE APPLIANCES & BULK ITEMS

Washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, grills, bicycles, lawnmowers and any other metal item larger than 9" x 48". **ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY.**

HOME ELECTRONICS (E-WASTE)

TVs/other home entertainment components, as well as computers, monitors, printers and scanners, etc.

PROPER DISPOSAL OF PAINT CANS

All paint must be completely dry. This can be achieved by opening the can and letting it sit until the paint is hard or by adding sand or cat litter to the can to absorb the paint. Once completely dry in may be placed in the household waste roll cart.



Recycle Days: Nov 17. Dec 1, 15, 30. Jan 12, 26. Feb. 9, 23. Schedule MAY change for weather, events, or holidays.

RECYCLING - EVERY OTHER FRIDAY

Place recycling in bins obtained from the Sangaree Special Tax District office. **Do not use plastic bags to contain your recycling.**

Items that are not acceptable will be left in your container after collection.

Place your recycling container at the curb.

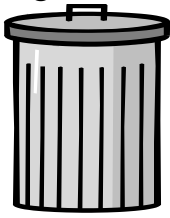
Recycling is divided into the following:

COMMINGLES - (plastic, glass, metal)

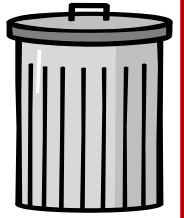
- **Plastic: #1 - #7 plastic containers.**
- Rinse and remove caps with the exception of cooking oil & motor oil bottles which should be un-rinsed with lids on. Labels are okay.
- **Glass: Unbroken jars and bottles.**
- Rinse and remove lids. Labels are okay. No mirrors, panes of glass or light bulbs.
- **Metal: Aluminum and steel cans.** Also, aluminum foil, pie pans, and empty aerosol cans. Rinse, labels are okay.

PAPER - Newspapers, magazines, mixed office paper, junk mail, store sales flyers, phone books, etc. placed in brown paper bags or recycle bin.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD - Remove packing material (Styrofoam, bubble wrap), collapse boxes and place inside recycle cart. For excessive amounts, contact the SSTD Office.



TALKING TRASH



HOUSEHOLD WASTE & RECYCLE ARE SCHEDULED TO BE PICKED UP BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00AM & 7:00PM. TO REPORT MISSED SERVICE PLEASE CALL THE SSTO OFFICE NO LATER THAN 11:00AM THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY.

YARD WASTE: Yard waste includes plant material removed from yard, NOT lawn furniture, fixtures, or decorations which are collected with furniture; no bricks, concrete edging or stones/rocks.

Keep the following three types of yard waste separate from each other and from other types of solid waste as they are collected separately.

LOOSE YARD WASTE: Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, pine cones, and trimmings from plants. Bagged in biodegradable **PAPER** bags (**NOT PLASTIC**) or placed in a container, such as a trash can, clearly marked "yard waste". Regulations prohibit the use of the same container for household trash and yard waste. Contained loose yard waste cannot exceed **65 pounds each**. Containers without lids must allow for drainage of rain water. **Bagged dirt will NOT be collected.**

LIMBS: Trunks and branches not exceeding four inches in diameter. Limbs are collected and chipped into a truck. Cut out forks, stack in an orderly pile not exceeding 4' high, with the cut ends towards the street. This allows for curbside collection as employees are not allowed to enter private property. Large quantities of limbs may be stacked in several piles or a continuous row.

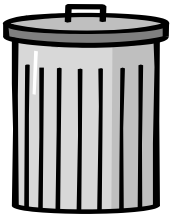

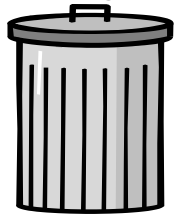

RECYCLE TIPS



Waste Pro of South Carolina is the contractor working in support of Sangaree's Recycle Program as well as servicing some of the commercial businesses in the area. In recent weeks, Waste Pro representatives have met with Sangaree staff and Berkeley County Representatives in an effort to improve services in the community. Many concerns and thoughts from the Sangaree residents have been shared with Waste Pro officials in an effort to have a better working relationship and service around Sangaree. Waste Pro is committed to the improvements discussed.

Recycling in Sangaree certainly helps our community and our planet. Recyclable items should be placed in the provided roll cart. Please see some of Waste Pro's informational graphics below regarding what is accepted as recyclable.

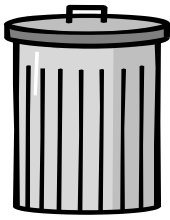

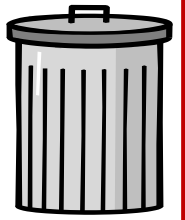


Aluminum Foil, **Plastic Bags**- including grocery bags, **Styrofoam**, Car Tires, **Yard Waste**, Disposable Diapers, **Waxed Cartons**, Kitchen Waste, **Wood**, Plate Glass, **Ceramic Mirrors**, Bubble Wrap, **Pizza Boxes**, and Paper or Cardboard products **that are wet or contaminated with food waste.**

Many Grocery Stores including Bi-Lo, Publix, and Walmart provide recycling bins for plastic grocery bags.

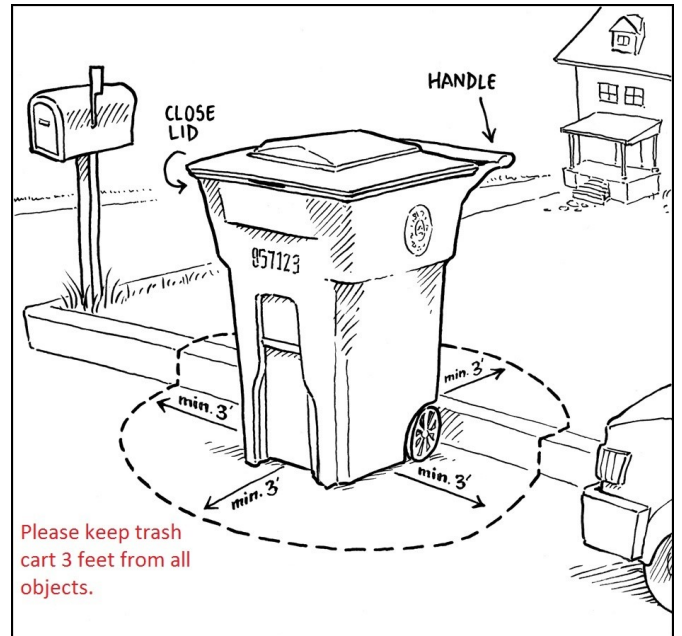
QUICK TRASH TIPS

Solid Waste service is provided between the hours of 7:00am and 7:00pm on your scheduled days.

Any items that are household waste should be placed in the provided roll cart.

Please place your cart at the curb before 7:00am the day of your scheduled service.

For more efficient disposal, place cart with wheels facing your house, lid opening facing towards the street.



Make sure your roll cart is accessible for the solid waste truck and clear of all obstructions: Parked cars, mail boxes, other carts, etc.

If you had your roll cart out by 7:00am and your service was missed, please contact the Sangaree Special Tax District office as soon as possible after 7:00pm on your scheduled day and no later than 11:00 the following day. The office will notify the contractor for make-up service. (843-871-9720)

If you have collapsed your cardboard and it does not fit in your roll cart, please call the SSTD Office. Collapsed cardboard can be picked up on an on-call basis. Household waste and other items placed inside cardboard boxes will NOT be picked-up.

A RECYCLE REMINDER: SSTD is participating in a Commingled Recycle Program, however plastic bags and Styrofoam are **NOT** recyclable in our area.

Remember to keep cul-de-sacs free of vehicles that may block the access necessary to get the large trucks through.

What are the responsibilities of the SSTD in Sangaree?

Residents of Sangaree Special Tax District receive public services and/or improvements, which could not otherwise conveniently or equitably be provided by Berkeley County. Some of the services we receive in Sangaree include, but are not limited to:



- 1) **Waste Management Service** - Residents have solid waste collected weekly that include household waste, recyclables, furniture, appliances, yard waste, and tree limbs.
- 2) **Recreation** – Residents enjoy an annual Community Day Event along with 44 parks, playgrounds, and green spaces maintained by Sangaree
- 3) **Fire Protection** – C & B Fire Department Sangaree Station and Pine Ridge Fire Department
- 4) **Maintenance**— Landscaper, General Maintenance crew, and an Administrative Staff work for Sangaree. Additional services are provided by the use of contracts with private companies approved by Berkeley County Council.

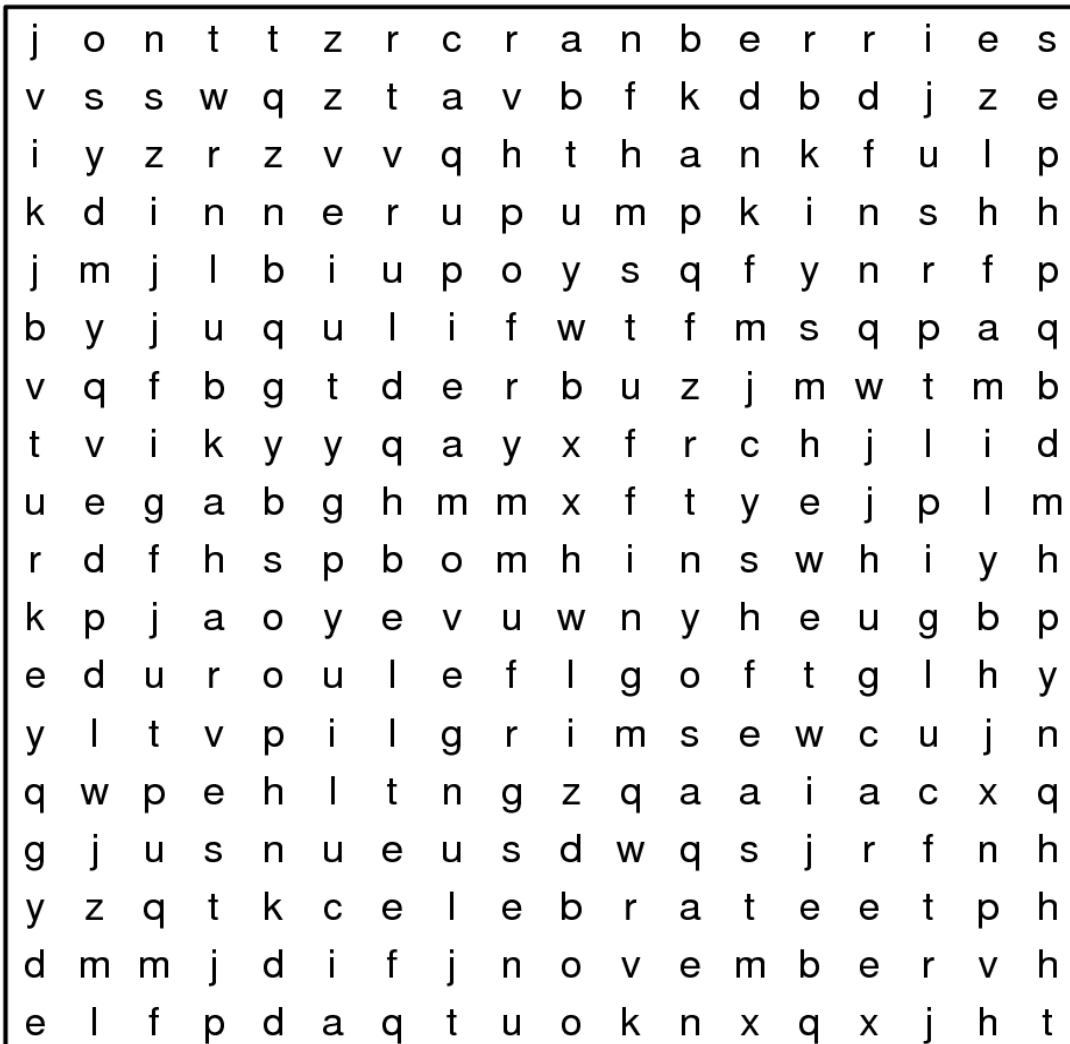

The Sangaree crew is not responsible for private property or the easement afforded property owners for access by utility or service workers. PETITION TO INSTALL/REPLACE STREET LIGHTING

We, the undersigned, understand that by our signatures, we are authorizing Berkeley Electric Cooperative, Inc. (BEC) to install/replace street lighting along the interior roadways of our subdivision. The type and size of lighting will be the 150 Watt Metal Halide Colonial Head Lights, at a ratio of 1 light per 4 houses, as listed in BEC's "SLS" rate. We also understand that the signatures of at least 85% of the BEC Members that reside within this subdivision, must appear on this petition before the street lighting system can be installed or changed. A BEC Account holder, and/or his heirs, successors and assigns, agree to pay BEC a monthly fee of \$4.80 per member, per month based on the proposed number of installed lights per the number of members for each light, as stated above.

Also that if BEC has to rebury or relocate its existing feed to accommodate new locations of lights, that the property owners will need to sign an easement allowing BEC to install new facilities on their property as proposed by BEC. Applicable State of South Carolina sales tax will apply. BEC will be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the street lighting system. As stated in our Outdoor Lighting Rates, in a case of recurrent vandalism, BEC does reserve the right to remove lights.

Please remember, your name must be on the bill for this to be valid.
