Yard Debris Removal

As a courtesy to your neighbors, Sangaree Crew and Contracted Staff, please do **NOT** throw yard debris, tree debris, pet waste, trash, etc., over your fence or off your property into Sangaree green space areas. This is illegal dumping and is fineable. Unexpected debris in the path of equipment can cause and has caused costly damage.

Do **NOT** place your disposed items (trash) onto green areas in cul-de-sacs. Curbside services are provided when items are placed at **your** curbside next to the road.

Yard Waste includes plant material removed from **YOUR YARD ONLY**. Such items include grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, pinecones, and trimmings from plants. Bricks, loose dirt, treated wood, concrete edging, stones/rocks are **NOT** considered Yard Waste and must be disposed of by the owner/landlord.

Yard Waste **MUST** be placed in a reusable container **CLEARLY MARKED YARD DEBRIS** that can be visible to the approaching service vehicle. Recyclable paper bags may also be used. Plastic bags are **NOT** permitted. Contained loose yard waste cannot exceed 65 pounds each.

Renovations & Home Projects

Please consider renting a roll-off container to dispose of your renovation, construction, and large remodel debris. Sangaree crews and contractors are not permitted to remove this debris from your property. This is also recommended for whole house clean outs such as an eviction.

All Berkeley County residents can use the multiple Convenience Centers located around Berkeley County. The nearest location to Sangaree is located at 606 Oakley Road in Moncks Corner.

Service Reminders

Trash Service - Place trash cart, yard debris, or allowed items at curbside **NO LATER THAN 6:30 AM** on your service days. **ALL** household trash **MUST BE** in the trash cart.

Sort DO NOT mix curbside debris piles - Your items will not be collected until debris is sorted properly.

Service Records - Trucks are equipped with cameras to determine if staff completed all stops on the route and whether or not carts were at curbside at time of service.

Second Carts - Additional carts are available from CWS for \$7.64 per month. To order an additional trash cart or carts, please call 843-553-2004.

If you are not sure, please call - Before beginning any major projects with your property, call the office and get your questions answered. This will help you prepare for your work ahead.

Berkeley County Convenience Centers - The Oakley Road location is open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays; **CLOSED Wednesdays and Sundays.** Oakley Road location - 606 Oakley Road, Moncks Corner, 29461

Missed Service - If your contracted trash or yard debris is missed, you must contact the Sangaree Office NO LATER THAN 10:30am the next business day to schedule make-up service.

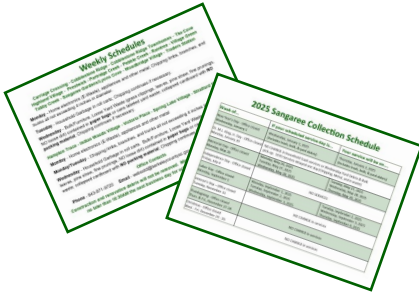

COMMUNITY DAY 2024

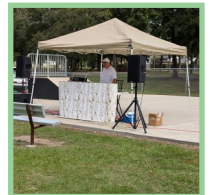


THANK YOU THANK YOU SANGAREE COMMUNITY!
