This does not prevent other ideas or plans from happening, but it will insure our future planning stays intact. The Berkeley County Council approved the plan at their December meeting. What's My District?

Sangaree began in 1975 as a Special Tax District in Berkeley County. Special taxes are paid by Sangaree residents. These taxes stay in Sangaree and are used for Sangaree maintenance and growth, *only*.

Berkeley County, as most of you know, is nestled in the beautiful Low Country of South Carolina. Moncks Corner, located 15 miles from Sangaree, is the County seat. Johnny Cribb is the County Supervisor. Located in District 4, we are represented on the Berkeley County Council by Berkeley County resident, Tommy Newell. Councilman Newell began his service to Berkeley County in 2015.

The public is always welcome to come to the County Council Meetings which are scheduled for the 4th Monday of the month, unless noted otherwise. You can find out about exciting plans that affect Sangaree like upcoming road resurfacing projects and more! You will be able to see how Berkeley County ***AND*** the Sangaree Special Tax District continues to be a great place to live!

Walking Bridge Improvements

Recent upgrades were made to one of the walking bridges located on the Sangaree Disc Golf Course.

The bridge was removed and five-foot diameter pipes were installed to keep the water in the Limehouse ditch flowing as it works it's way to the Goose Creek Reservoir.

Berkeley County Roads and Bridges crews worked to build up the surrounding ground, reposition the bridge, and anchor it securely. Hydroseed was spread in the area around the bridge.

It looks great and is already back to getting regular foot traffic. Visit Sangaree Park of the Disc Golf Course and check it out!
